The Central District Health Department is offering the **MEASLES, MUMPS AND RUBELLA** vaccine to both children and adults.

COST: Adults will be charged a \$38 fee. Insurance may be billed and a sliding-fee scale used for both adults and children.

ELIGIBILITY: The MMR is given to children between the ages of 12 and 15 months and again between 4 and 6 years. Adults born in or after 1957 who have never received one dose of the MMR vaccine are eligible for this clinic

CDHD regularly provides **all** vaccines to children from birth to age 18. Appointments for the MMR and any other vaccines are available for children outside of the specified dates.
